

He is Alive!!! He is Risen!!! Jesus' death and resurrection accomplished three things for every Christian:

1. Forgiveness — We have all sinned. Jesus died on the cross and took the punishment that we deserve. He conquered death to forgive us for our sins.
2. Focus — The disciples went from scared men in hiding to men who boldly professed their faith in Jesus and started the Church! The resurrection gave them and should give us a focus in our lives.
3. Future — Jesus proved that death is not the end! The resurrection gives us hope and a future that is beyond this world.

The resurrection is the most powerful truth, and it's the basis for our faith.

Jesus said, "I am the resurrection and the life. The one who believes in Me, even if he dies, will live. Everyone who lives and believes in Me will never die—ever. Do you believe this?"

“Yes, Lord,” she told Him, “I believe You are the Messiah, the Son of God, who was to come into the world.”

For we know that our old self was crucified with Him in order that sin's dominion over the body may be abolished, so that we may no longer be enslaved to sin, since a person who has died is freed from sin's claims.

Men: Now if we died with Christ, we believe that we will also live with Him, because we know that Christ, having been raised from the dead, no longer dies.

Women: Death no longer rules over Him. For in that He died, He died to sin once for all; but in that He lives, He lives to God.

So, you too consider yourselves dead to sin, but alive to God in Christ Jesus. For in Him, we live and move and exist.
